Resolution authorizing a Professional Service Contract with raSmith to provide construction management of private property improvements for the City of West Allis for an amount not to exceed \$327,750

WHEREAS, The Common Council passed resolution R-2019-0256 on April 1, 2019 authorizing the City Engineer to enter into an agreement for reimbursement from MMSD to fund the disconnection of foundation drains and sanitary lateral rehabilitations on all 2019 street reconstructions in an amount not to exceed \$690,000; and,

WHEREAS, the City of West Allis will enter into a contract to perform this work based on MMSD's funding proposal; and,

WHEREAS, The Common Council passed a resolution R-2018-0208 on April 4, 2018 Authorizing Execution of the Department of Natural Resources Principal Forgiven Financial Assistance Agreement in an amount up to \$1,400,000 to undertake a project to replace private lead service lines; and,

WHEREAS, the City of West Allis will undertake a project to replace private lead service lines at residences, and licensed day care centers; and,

WHEREAS, The Engineering Department has reported that it duly advertised a request for proposal for engineering consultant services to provide construction management of private property improvements, and that the proposals received were reasonable; and,

WHEREAS, subsequent to the highest rated firm meeting our requirements, the evaluation team recommended that the contract award be made to the best qualified firm, raSmith; and,

WHEREAS, the Common Council deems it to be in the best interests of the City of West Allis that the proposal of raSmith be accepted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of West Allis that the proposal dated August 16, 2019 submitted by raSmith for furnishing Engineering Consulting Services to provide construction management of private property improvements for the City of West Allis for an amount not to exceed \$327,750 in

accordance with the corresponding City of West Allis RFP be and is hereby accepted. Funding for this purchase will be reimbursed through the MMSD Private Property Infiltration and Inflow Reduction Agreement No. 7 and through the Department of Natural Resources Principal Forgiven Financial Assistance Agreement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Engineer be and is hereby authorized to enter into a Professional Services Contract with raSmith.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Engineer be and is hereby authorized to make such substantive changes, modifications, additions and deletions to and from the various provisions of the proposal from raSmith as may be necessary and proper to correct inconsistencies, eliminate ambiguity and otherwise clarify and supplement said provisions to preserve and maintain the general intent thereof and to protect the interests of the City, including but not limited to, any and all changes necessary to preserve the intent of the Common Council of the City of West Allis.
